

Key Differentiators of the YouthTruth Survey

- YouthTruth provides detailed comparative data in a user-friendly format
 - Compare students' perspectives by teacher
 - Compare schools to others in the same district/network and to national sample
 - Compare districts and portfolios of schools
- **❖** Youth Truth engages staff and students at multiple touch points to make the data "stick"
 - Close feedback loop with students
 - Employ comprehensive sharing process with school leaders
 - Position school leaders to respond to feedback

Feedback That Leads to Change

- In an independent evaluation, 98% of participants had used or had plans to use YouthTruth data to make specific changes (2010)
- 92% of repeat schools said that YouthTruth data had informed changes in their school's decision-making or processes (2011)
