The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe Graphic Novel Project

For this project, you will be writing/illustrating a 36 panel (minimum) graphic novel. You may choose one of the following two choices:



- 1. Write a graphic novel version of The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe.
- 2. Create you own fantasy story using elements we have discussed in the story, including:
 - a. The discovery of an alternate world
 - b. An "animal helper" (guide) who assists the main character(s)
 - c. A conflict between good and evil

The requirements for this project are:

- o 36 story panels minimum
- o A complete story (Rising action, conflict, climax, falling action, resolution)
- o A title panel
- o Varying panel layouts
 - o Gutters, frames, panel sizes, various zooming
- o Lettering of the following kinds:
 - Captions (for narration, reflection, transitions such as, "Meanwhile...")
 - Speech Balloons
 - Thought Balloons
- o Visuals including:
 - Setting/scenery
 - Emotions/facial expressions and actions
 - <u>Distinct</u> characters
