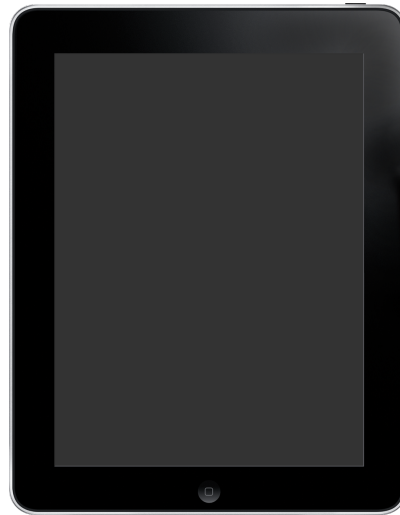

# Ways To Use Digital Books

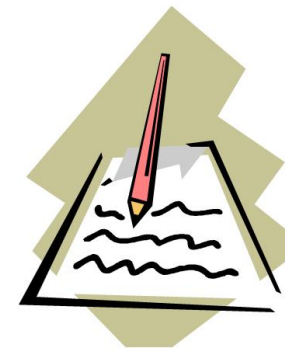
## Front Load a Lesson/Unit:

- introduce new vocabulary and/or concepts
- provide background information



## Formative Assessment:

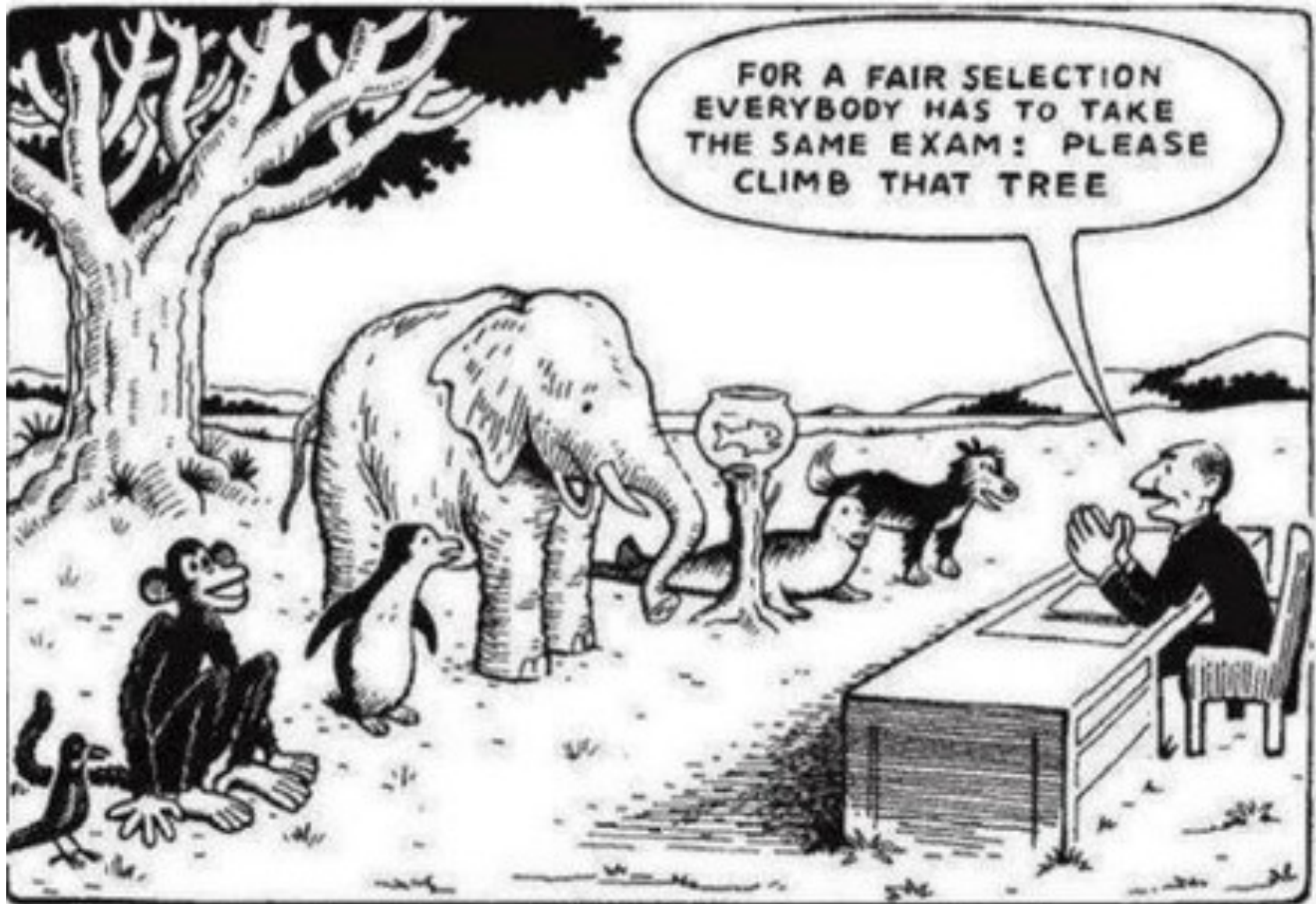
- students create a book using newly learned vocabulary and/or concepts
- students create assessments for each other
- you can make an assessment for students
